#### **KMC PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE**

The Govt. has introduced <u>Bill C-21 (the Firearms</u> <u>Bill)</u> which will affect all Acadian Métis gun owners and hunters. If the proposed amendments to this bill become law, many of Canada's 2.2 million licensed firearms owners could be criminalized.

This new legislation hearkens back to a time when the British were attempting to gain control of Nova Scotia in the 1700s. Acadian Métis were looked upon then as a threat to the British, and their firearms were confiscated. In my opinion, history is repeating itself.

Bill C-21 does impact First Nations' firearms. Métis people are also Indigenous people whose rights should be considered under the same section 35 of the *Constitution Act*, 1982.

As Acadian Métis, we must stand united and keep our memberships in good standing.

We would encourage you to familiarize yourself with the following treaties: 1) the <u>RATIFICATION</u> <u>OF THE PEACE AND FRIENDSHIP TREATY</u> signed by Mathieu Mius in 1726; and 2) Père Jean-Mandé <u>SIGOGNE'S 1812 COPY OF THE</u> <u>1761 PEACE AND FRIENDSHIP TREATY</u>, signed by François Mius as Chief of "the Tribe of La Hève Indians". Copies of these treaties will be available through the KMC Office.

Let us hope this will help us Métis.
